Parents

Guardians

A guardian of a child also has lawful authority. A legal guardian is given lawful authority by a court order. The definition of "guardian" under the Children's Services Act 1996 also covers situations where a child does not live with his or her parents and there are no court orders. In these cases, the guardian is the person the child lives with who has day-to-day care and control of the child.
