

Keilor Public Golf Course Cart Usage Policy

This Cart Usage policy is written to provide a clear do's and don'ts list for all cart users. Failure to adhere to these rules will result in the cart user being asked to leave the facility.

Please note that all cart hires will require documentation to be completed, as well as a valid driving license submitted to the Proshop for reference throughout your hire.

The Hirer is responsible for all damage to the cart and will be responsible for repayment of the repair for the damage. Reporting damage already incurred must be reported prior to the tee off.





Do the following:

- ✓ Drive responsibly and with due care for the course and other golfers;
- √ Exercise caution at all times;
- ✓ Drive slowly (5 km/h) when turning or in the vicinity of the proshop;
- √ Observe and comply with all directional signage;
- √ Give way to walking golfers at all times;
- ✓ Give way to vehicles and pedestrians when in the vicinity of the proshop;
- √ Drive on cart paths where provided;
- √ Keep arms and legs inside the cabin at all times when the cart is in motion;
- √ Inspect the cart for any damage or faults prior to commencing your round;
- ✓ Report all damage sustained during hire period to the Golf Shop.





Don't do the following:

- Drive or park the cart within 5 metres of tees/bunkers/hazards unless cart is on cart path;
- Drive or park the cart between greenside bunkers and the green;
- Drive or park the cart within 10 metres of the front of a green;
- Drive the cart in or through the rough (i.e. off the fairway) or areas of GUR;
- Drive the cart in areas where there are staked trees or plants with guards;
- Drive the cart through puddles, mud or casual water;
- Drive the cart when adversely affected by alcohol, drugs or medication;
- Drive the cart from the passenger side;
- Drive the cart when either or both of the driver and passenger are not seated or not fully contained within the cabin;
- Drive or park the cart within 2 metres of another cart;
- Brake heavily causing the cart to skid;
- Allow persons under 18 to drive the cart;
- Use the cart with more than 2 persons;
- Use a mobile phone while driving the cart;
- Continue to drive if the cart feels unsafe or has sustained damage;
- Continue to drive if a tyre is flat or punctured;
- Drive the golf cart outside the property of the Keilor Public Golf Course The cart should not
